1.2 RPATC, Dhaka will facilitate the arrangement of accommodation and food for you during your stay at the Centre. It is worth mentioning that the cost of your food will be met from the budget of course.

1.3 As a participant, you have to follow the prescribed dress code of RPATC, Dhaka. During classroom sessions, male participants must wear full pant, light colored (preferably white

colored) full sleeved shirt with tie supplied by the Centre and shoe. However, sherwani/panjabi with 'coti' can also be worn on religious ground. You are expected to wear lounge suit (Blazer- preferably black/deep blue colored) during some special occasions. Female participants, on the other hand, must wear saree/salwar suits although they are expected to wear saree on some special occasions. You also need to bring white colored sports dress and shoe/keds for attending physical exercise, games etc.

1.4 Please bring 4 (four) copies of your recent passport size color photographs for registration and other official purposes. You are also requested to bring flash drive, laptop (if possible).

1.5 You have to arrive at RPATC, Dhaka **on Saturday 26 January 2019 before 05:00 p. m.** and report at the Reception of RPATC, Dhaka. Please note that a briefing session will be held at 7 p. m. that day.
